**PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION PROHIBITING ENFORCEMENT OF
SELECTED PROVISIONS OF INDIANA HOUSE ENROLLED ACT NO. 1337**

The State of Indiana, its agents and agencies, and all political subdivisions thereof are prohibited from enforcing the following provisions of Indiana House Enrolled Act No. 1337:

- the anti-discrimination provisions, Indiana Code §§ 16-34-4-4, 16-34-4-5, 16-34-4-6, 16-34-4-7, 16-34-4-8;
- the information dissemination provision, Indiana Code § 16-34-2-1.1(a)(1)(K); and
- all the fetal tissue disposition provisions, Indiana Code §§ 16-34-3-4(a), Indiana Code 16-41-16-4(d).

Plaintiffs are not required to post a bond.


