In October, we launched our first TikTok series, **RNG News Flash**, a weekly round-up of all things reproductive justice.

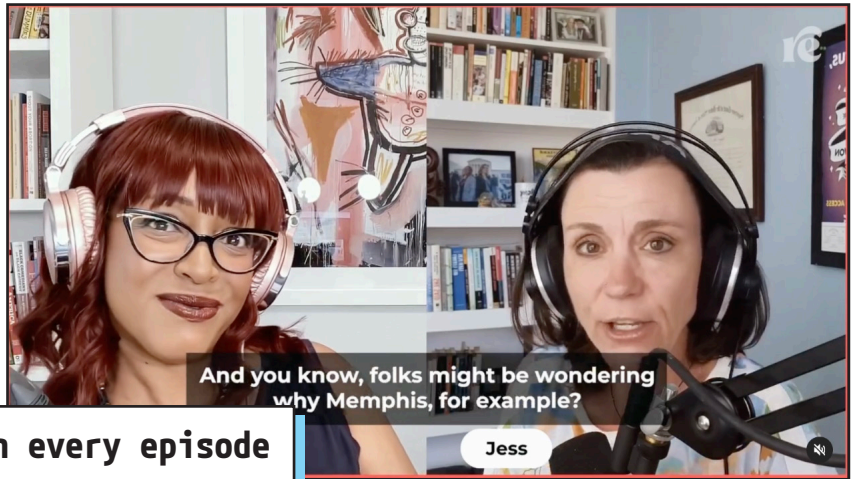
Within two months, we had over **82,000** engagements. In 2024, we expect to reach an audience of over **250,000** TikTok users.

The Florida Supreme Court on Monday took a page from *Dobbs v.
